Welcome to our historic first Academic Awards Ceremonies as the University of Sunderland.

With the award of City Status, Sunderland's City Challenge success and an appearance at the FA Cup Final, 1992 has been a tremendous year for Wearside. Many of the students receiving awards today have played a valuable role in the Sunderland Success Story. Many have enjoyed fruitful placements in local industry and commerce and some have improved the standing of the University in the local community through voluntary work for such organisations as Wear FM, the campus-based radio station, which was this year voted Radio Station of the Year in the prestigious Sony Awards.

We regard education as an asset for life, and it is appropriate that the achievements of distinguished individuals and institutions should be recognised alongside those of our own students. Times are changing rapidly in higher education, and it seems strange to think that the students here today enrolled on a course not at a University, but at a Polytechnic. Honorary Awards

HILARY ARMSTRONG MP

Born in 1945, Hilary Jane Armstrong is MP for North West Durham. She was educated at Monkwearmouth Comprehensive School, Sunderland, graduated in Sociology from West Ham College of Technology and gained a Diploma in Social Work at Birmingham University. She worked as a social worker with Newcastle Social Services (1970-73) and Southwick Neighbourhood Action Project, Sunderland (1973-75). She joined the then Sunderland Polytechnic as a Lecturer in Community and Youth Work in 1975 and taught until she was elected to Parliament in 1987. Between 1988-92, she was a member of the Education Front Bench Team, responsible for pre-school and primary education and equal opportunities. She is currently Parliamentary Private Secretary to Labour Leader, John Smith.

THE CITY OF SUNDERLAND

On 23 March 1992, Her Majesty The Queen commanded that: "Sunderland should have the status of a City." Sunderland is an ancient settlement, and traces of human habitation date back 10,000 years. Formally granted a charter by Bishop Puiset in 1154, it became a Parliamentary Borough and Municipal Corporation in the 1830s. Established as a Metropolitan Borough in 1974, Sunderland is now the largest population centre between Leeds and Edinburgh. Internationally renowned for its glassmaking and shipbuilding traditions, Sunderland is now establishing itself as a major centre for Advanced Manufacturing Technology. Famous Sunderland residents have included the first English Historian, the Venerable Bede; electric lighting pioneer Joseph Swan; and BBC TV journalist, Kate Adie.

MYRELLA COHEN QC

Her Honour Judge Myrella Cohen was the first woman barrister, the first woman QC and the first woman to occupy professional judicial office in the North East. Born in 1927, she was educated at Manchester High School for Girls and Colwyn Bay Grammar School. She was Called to the Bar in 1950, after graduating from Manchester University and in 1972 became only the third woman in Britain to be appointed a Judge. A Judge at Sunderland County Court for several years, who presided over North East Crown Courts, she left the region in 1988 to preside over courts at Harrow Crown Court, the Central Criminal Court (Old Bailey) and act as a Judge in the Family Division of the High Court. President of Sunderland Soroptimists and Sunderland Cancer Research Campaign, she was a founder of the Sunderland Group of the League of Jewish Women and is a Life Member of its National Council. Founder and President of Sunderland Family Conciliation Service, she is also Patron of Sunderland Council for the Disabled. Her husband, Lieutenant Colonel Mordaunt Cohen, was the first Chairman of the Board of Governors of the former Sunderland Polytechnic.

SIR TOM COWIE OBE

Sir Tom Cowie went into business selling used motorcycles from a small shop at Matamba Terrace, Sunderland, on June 1st, 1948, with capital of £1,000. Forty years later he is still in business at the same address and is Chairman of T. Cowie plc, one of the fastest-growing motor sales and finance companies in Europe. The Company, which is one of Britain's top 250, has Britain's largest fleet of vehicles on contract hire and a turnover of around £565m a year. Sir Tom is a former Chairman of Sunderland Football Club and received an OBE in 1982 for his political service. Sir Tom is well known for his charitable work in the North East, and for his involvement in the Prince of Wales Community Venture, which encourages projects involving young people. He received his knighthood in the Queen's New Year Honours List in 1992.

DR SUE HURLEY

Dr. Sue Hurley is Regional Director of the Open University. A graduate of Manchester University, she went on to gain a PhD in Plant Biochemistry. After two years on a Harkness Postdoctoral Fellowship to the University of Illinois in the United States, Dr. Hurley returned to Britain to lecture at London University. Dr. Hurley has played a key role in improving access to education for adults, particularly women, in the North East. She has been instrumental in the development of courses for childcare workers and 'A Hitch-hiker's Guide', an innovative programme to help adults on Wearside come to terms with Science and Technology. Dr. Hurley is a member of the University of Sunderland's Board of Governors.

DAVE STEWART

David Allan Stewart was born in Sunderland on 9th September 1952. Together with Annie Lennox he formed the Tourists in 1977. The Tourists split up in 1979 but Stewart and Lennox stayed together to form Eurythmics. The duo's phenomenal success includes worldwide sales of over 30 million albums and sell-out concert tours throughout the world. Dave Stewart has won a wide range of music industry awards including Best Artist, Songwriter and Producer. Dave has produced major Artists including Mick Jagger, Darryl Hall and John Oates, Bob Dylan, Tom Petty and Shakespear's Sister. He also composes film and TV soundtracks and movie scores, including: "Ruthless People", "Scrooged" and "Flatliners". Dave owns and runs the successful record and publishing companies Anxious Records and Anxious Music and has established companies in the UK and United States for the development of feature films, drama and TV programmes.

The Honorary Fellowship for Dave Stewart was conferred in a special ceremony at the University's Langham Tower on 5th November, 1992.

SIR RICHARD STOREY, Bt

Born in 1937, Sir Richard Storey has been the Chairman of Portsmouth and Sunderland Newspapers plc since 1973. A graduate of Trinity College, Cambridge, he completed his national service before being Called to the Bar in 1962. He was a director of Reuters between 1986-92 and of the Press Association since 1986 (Chairman, 1991). He was President of the Newspaper Society 1990-91, having been a member since 1986. He has been a trustee of the Botanic Gardens, Kew Foundation since 1991 and is currently High Sheriff of North Yorkshire. Sir Richard was a member of the CBI's Employment Policy Committee, 1984-88 and the organisation's Regional Council between 1984-88. He was a member of the Press Council between 1980-86 and became a member of the European Newspaper Publishers' Association in 1991.

SUNDERLAND AFC

In 1879, James Allan, a Sunderland schoolmaster, visited Scotland on holiday and saw the increasing popularity of 'the dribbling game' (football). He introduced it to his colleagues in the schoolyard and the interest created led to the foundation of a Sunderland and District Teachers Association Football Club. Overcoming initial financial difficulties and dropping the "and District Teachers" from its title, the club rapidly established itself as one of Britain's leading teams. Elected to the Football League in 1899, Sunderland has won the League Championship on six occasions and the FA Cup twice, in 1937 and 1973. Runner-up to Liverpool in the 1992 FA Cup Final, Sunderland is currently Football Trust Community Club of the Year.

UNIVERSITY MACE

The University of Sunderland's new ceremonial mace reflects the finest local craftsmanship.

Completely designed and manufactured on Wearside, the mace will be carried at the head of the degree ceremony parades.

Its glass head, expertly fashioned in stained-glass, is modelled on the vibrant sun-burst emblem of the University of Sunderland and reflects the City's long glass-making tradition.

The head was designed and assembled by Roger Tye of the Phoenix Hot Glass Studio, Houghton-le-Spring, aided by Rebecca Oliver, a University of Sunderland Ceramics and Glassware student.

The mace's nickel and chromium-plated shaft was manufactured free of charge by Grove World Wide of Pallion, Sunderland.

WORLD PREMIERE OF PROCESSIONAL FANFARE

To celebrate its University status, the University of Sunderland has commissioned a Processional Fanfare from the Sunderland-born composer Edward Gregson. Funded with the support of Northern Arts, the Processional will receive its World Premiere at the Academic Awards Ceremony at Sunderland Empire Theatre on the morning of Friday, 13 November. The Processional will be performed at the 13, 20 and 27 November Academic Awards Ceremonies by a brass quintet provided by the Northern Sinfonia.

EDWARD GREGSON One of Britain's most versatile composers, Edward Gregson has written extensively for orchestra, choir, wind ensemble and brass band. His concerti for horn, trumpet, tuba and trombone have been performed regularly by the major British orchestras and he is currently writing a Clarinet Concerto for Michael Collins and the BBC Symphony Orchestra. Edward Gregson is also known for his theatre and television music, which includes commissions from the Royal Shakespeare Company and the theme music for BBC TV's 'Young Musician of the Year'. Active as a conductor of contemporary music both in the UK and overseas, Edward Gregson is Reader in Music at Goldsmith's College, University of London.

THE NORTHERN SINFONIA Founded in Newcastle-upon-Tyne in 1958, the Northern Sinfonia is now widely regarded as one of the world's finest chamber orchestras. The only professional orchestra serving a vast area of Northern England, the Sinfonia appointed Heinrich Schiff, the renowned Austrian 'cellist and conductor, as Artistic Director in 1990. The Sinfonia was awarded an Honorary Fellowship by the then Sunderland Polytechnic in 1991.

THE CEREMONIES

* Guests must be seated in the auditorium at least 10 minutes before the start of the ceremony.

* The congregation should stand as the procession enters and leaves the theatre.

* No smoking please in the theatre.

* You may take photographs inside the theatre, but should not obstruct the procession as it enters and leaves.

* The use of video equipment inside the theatre is not permitted.

* Refreshments will be served in Wearmouth Hall immediately after each ceremony.

* Photographers will be available in the Forster Building after each ceremony if you wish to use their services - all official photographers will be identified by a special badge.

ACADEMIC DRESS

Graduates will be robed in their appropriate Academic Dress. Staff will wear robes appropriate to their Institutions. Degrees being conferred at this Ceremony are Degrees of the Council for National Academic Awards.

Doctor of Philosophy

Doctorates are awarded for extended research of a more fundamental nature.

The gown is black with facing and yoke of maroon with a hood of gold panama lined with maroon and a black cloth bonnet with cord and tassels of maroon.

Master's Degrees

Second degrees are awarded, to those holding a degree, for research or for further study and examination.

The gown is black with a gold panama hood, fully lined with white.

Bachelor's Degrees

New graduates will be receiving Bachelor of Science (BSc), Bachelor of Engineering (BEng), Bachelor of Education (BEd) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) degrees.

The gown is black with a gold panama hood lined with a turquoise blue.

Diplomas and Certificates

Students successfully completing courses leading to the award of diplomas and certificates are entitled to wear the University's academic dress.

The gown is black with a blue hood, lined in mauve and tipped in nasturtium.

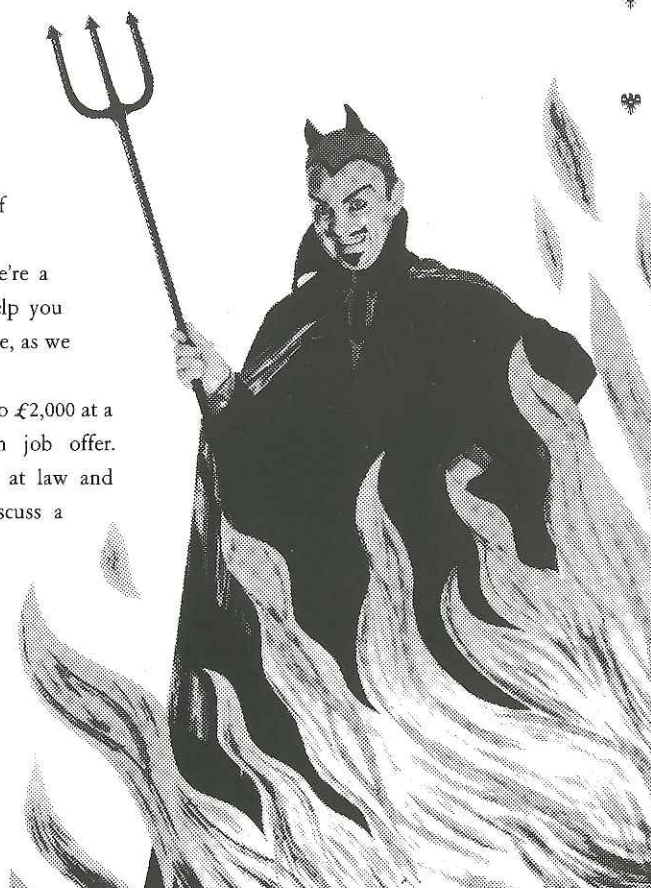
