We are celebrating our 25th anniversary as a University in 2017. To reflect this we are increasing this popular loyalty payment for alumni to £1,000 for Sept/Oct 2017 entry.

Terms and Conditions

The Scheme

A £1,000 cash payment is made to any UK/EU graduate (an alumni) of the University of Sunderland as an incentive to study a full-time postgraduate course (see *eligibility below*). International alumni who enrol will receive a £1,000 fee waiver instead of a cash payment.

This payment only applies to alumni who enrol on a full-time masters-level postgraduate course delivered at our Sunderland sites starting in Sept/Oct 2017.

The cash payment to UK/EU alumni will be made by BACS directly into the student's bank account in February 2018. The fee waiver for international students will be applied when the course fee is due.

Eligibility

The scheme is open to ALL Level 5 - 8 graduates (Alumni) of the University of Sunderland. To qualify for this special discount, applicants must meet the relevant entry criteria for the course.

Eligible programmes are full-time masters-level and research postgraduate courses (MA, MSc, LLM, MBA, PhD - excluding PGCE's). The individual course pages on our website: www.sunderland.ac.uk provide price information and details on specific entry requirements.

Part-time courses and other degree classifications are NOT included in this scheme.

To be eligible for this discount scheme you will have received a relevant Level 5–8 qualification (on campus at Sunderland or London or off-campus with a TNE partner) from Sunderland Polytechnic or the University of Sunderland (full-time or part-time) or have successfully completed a study abroad or exchange programme at Level 5-8 at the University.
