

The Richard Studham Ceramics Scholarship

The University is the recipient of a generous donation to support students applying to study MA Visual Practice: Ceramics in academic year 2025-26.

Funded by Professor Richard L Studham, this award will support one scholarship of £1,000 and provide a successful student funding to explore an external practise related opportunity.

Professor Studham studied at Sunderland College of Art and Design in the 1950's which formed the basis of his career in academia becoming a professional ceramic artist exhibiting worldwide. Richard attributes his career success to his days studying in Sunderland and advocates his passion for education by providing financial support to this programme.

Criteria:

Applicants must be a postgraduate studying MA Visual Practice: Ceramics beginning academic year October 2025. Applicants must include an outline of their proposal, opportunity secured, clear timelines and costings of what the financial support is to cover via the MS Form.

The application should clearly set out how this award would make a difference to final year study and your future career aspirations post-graduation.
